Rom. 3²³ for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, ²⁴ being **JUSTIFIED freely** by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, ²⁵ whom God set forth *as* a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed, ²⁶ to demonstrate at the present time His righteousness, that He might be **just and the justifier** of the one who has faith in Jesus.

Justification means: to DECLARE righteous, not to MAKE righteous
