# THE TESTIMONY OF JOHN Dr. John Niemelä December 11, 2005 Grace Chapel

#### Introduction

John  $21^{24}$ This is the disciple who <u>testifies</u> of these things, and wrote these things; and we know that his testimony is true.

John 20<sup>30</sup>And truly Jesus did <u>many other signs in the presence of His disciples</u>, which are not written in this book; <sup>31</sup>but these [<u>signs done in the presence of His disciples</u>] are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name.

John 2<sup>11</sup>This beginning of signs Jesus did <u>in Cana of Galilee</u>, and manifested His glory; and <u>His disciples believed in Him</u>.

John 4<sup>54</sup>This again is the second sign Jesus did when He had come out of Judea into Galilee.

#### 1. John the Baptist as Witness 1

- **A.** 1<sup>7</sup>This man came for a <u>witness</u>, to <u>bear witness</u> of the Light, that all through him might believ**e.** <sup>8</sup>He was not that Light, but was sent to <u>bear witness</u> of that Light.
- **B.** 1<sup>15</sup>John <u>bore witness</u> of Him and cried out, saying, "This was He of whom I said, 'He who comes after me is preferred before me, for He was before me.' "
- C. 1<sup>19</sup>Now this is the <u>testimony</u> of John, when the Judeans sent priests and Levites from Jerusalem to ask him, "Who are you?"
- **D.** 1<sup>32</sup>And John <u>bore witness</u>, saying, "I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and He remained upon Him.... <sup>34</sup>And I have seen and <u>testified</u> that this is the Son of God."

# 2. Christ and Testimony 1

- E. 2<sup>25</sup> and had no need that anyone should <u>testify</u> of man, for He knew what was in man.
- **F.** 3<sup>11</sup>Most assuredly, I say to you, We speak what We know and <u>testify</u> what We have seen, and you do not receive Our <u>witness</u>.

Why does He say we in this passage?

## 3. John the Baptist as Witness 2

**G.** 3<sup>26</sup>And they came to John and said to him, "Rabbi, He who was with you beyond the Jordan, to whom you have <u>testified</u> -- behold, He is baptizing, and all are coming to Him!" ... <sup>28</sup>You yourselves <u>bear</u> me <u>witness</u>, that I said, 'I am not the Christ,' but, 'I have been sent before Him.' ... <sup>32</sup>And what He has seen and heard, that He <u>testifies</u>; and no one receives His testimony. <sup>33</sup>He who has received His testimony has certified that God is true.

## 4. The Samaritan Woman as Witness

**H.** 4<sup>39</sup>And many of the Samaritans of that city believed in Him because of the word of the woman who testified, "He told me all that I ever did."

## 5. Christ and Testimony 2

- **I.** 4<sup>44</sup>For Jesus Himself <u>testified</u> that a prophet has no honor in his own country.
- J. 5<sup>31</sup>If I bear witness of Myself, My witness is not true. <sup>32</sup>There is another who bears witness of Me, and I know that the witness which He witnesses of Me is true. <sup>33</sup>You have sent to John, and he has borne witness to the truth. <sup>34</sup>Yet I do not receive testimony from man, but I say these things that you may be saved.... <sup>36</sup>But I have a greater witness than John's; for the works which the Father has given Me to finish -- the very works that I do -- bear witness of Me, that the Father has sent Me. <sup>37</sup>And the Father Himself, who sent Me, has testified of Me. You have neither heard His voice at any time, nor seen His form.... <sup>39</sup>You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; and these are they which testify of Me.

# 5. Christ and Testimony 2 (CONTINUED)

- **K.** 7<sup>7</sup>The world cannot hate you, but it hates Me because I <u>testify</u> of it that its works are evil.
- **L.** 8<sup>13</sup>The Pharisees therefore said to Him, "You <u>bear witness</u> of Yourself; Your <u>witness</u> is not true." <sup>14</sup>Jesus answered and said to them, "Even if I <u>bear witness</u> of Myself, My <u>witness</u> is true, for I know where I came from and where I am going; but you do not know where I come from and where I am going. <sup>17</sup>It is also written in your law that the <u>testimony</u> of two men is true. <sup>18</sup>I am One who <u>bears witness</u> of Myself, and the Father who sent Me <u>bears witness</u> of Me.
- **M.** 10<sup>25</sup>Jesus answered them, "I told you, and you do not believe. The works that I do in My Father's name, they bear witness of Me.

#### 6. Judeans who Testified

**N.** 12<sup>17</sup>Therefore the people, who were with Him when He called Lazarus out of his tomb and raised him from the dead, bore witness.

## 7. Christ and Testimony 3

**O.** 13<sup>21</sup>When Jesus had said these things, He was troubled in spirit, and <u>testified</u> and said, "Most assuredly, I say to you, one of you will betray Me."

### 8. Testimony of the Holy Spirit

**P.** 15<sup>26</sup>But when the Helper comes, whom I shall send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth who proceeds from the Father, He will <u>testify</u> of Me.

## 9. Testimony of the Disciples

Q. 15<sup>27</sup>And you also will <u>bear witness</u>, because you have been with Me from the beginning.

# 10. Challenge to the High Priest to Testify

**R.** 18<sup>23</sup>Jesus answered him, "If I have spoken evil, <u>bear witness</u> of the evil; but if well, why do you strike Me?"

# 11. Christ and Testimony 4

**S.** 18<sup>37</sup>Pilate therefore said to Him, "Are You a king then?" Jesus answered, "You say rightly that I am a king. For this cause I was born, and for this cause I have come into the world, that I should <u>bear witness</u> to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth hears My voice."

## 12. Testimony of John

- **T.** 19<sup>35</sup>And he who has seen has <u>testified</u>, and his <u>testimony</u> is true; and he knows that he is telling the truth, so that you may believe.
- **U.** 21<sup>24</sup>This is the disciple who <u>testifies</u> of these things, and wrote these things; and we know that his <u>testimony</u> is true.
