

3:14-15 Paul bows his knees [= prays] to the Father of Jesus Christ, because He is the Father of the whole fatherhood [= the Church].

3:16 [Paul's prayer is] that the Father would use the Holy Spirit to strengthen the Ephesians in their innermost being.

3:17a [Paul's purpose for praying for strengthening by the Spirit] is that Christ [and His word] would be at home in them.

3:17b-19a [The purposes for Christ being at home in these already-rooted-and-grounded-in-Christ's-love-believers is so they would (1) comprehend the extensiveness of Christ's love, and (2) so they would increasingly know Christ's love that we can never fully know].

3:19b The purpose for comprehending/knowing Christ's love is so we may manifest God's character.

The content of 3:13-15 is 3:16. The purpose of 3:16 is 3:17a. The purpose of 3:17a is 3:17b-19a. The purpose of 3:17b-19a is 3:19b.
