Ephesus **Sm**yrna **Per**gamos **Th**yatira **S**ardis, **Background: Lydian Empire** The contribution of Sardis to the modern world **Background: The Roman Province of Lydia** Jesus, the all knowing, told the angelos of Sardis that, despite his reputation, he is dead (Rev 3:1) The angelos needs to be watchful and to repair what has fallen into disrepair (3:2) The angelos is to go back to what he was taught, be steadfast, and repent (3:3a)

Unless the angelos repents soon, the Lord will unexpectedly discipline him (3:3b)

A few in the assembly had not defiled their garments; they will walk with the Lord in white (3:4)
The overcomer will be clothed in white and will not have his name blotted from the book of life (3:5)
This is another example of litotes (Cf. Rev 2:11)
No one will be blotted from the Book of Life, because the life that is given is everlasting
