#### Introduction

## Jesus in Batanea (10:40-42)

10<sub>40</sub> So He departed again across the Jordan to the place [*Batanea*] where John was baptizing at first, and He remained there.

 $_{41}$  And many came to Him and were saying, "John did no sign, but everything that John said about this man was true."  $_{42}$  So many there believed in Him.

#### Lazarus Dies in Bethany (11:1-16)

- $11_1$  Now a certain man was sick, Lazarus from Bethany, the village of Mary and her sister Martha.  $_2$  Now Mary was who anointed the Lord with fragrant oil and wiped His feet with her hair, whose brother Lazarus was sick.
- 3 So the sisters sent Him a message, saying, "Behold. Lord, he whom You love is sick."
- <sup>4</sup> Upon hearing *this*, Jesus said, "This sickness is not unto death, but for the glory of God, so the Son of God may be glorified through it." <sub>5</sub> Now Jesus loved Martha, her sister *Mary*, and Lazarus.
- 6 So, when He heard that he was sick, He stayed for two days in the place [Batanea] where He was.
- 7 Then, after this, He told the disciples, "Let us go to Judea again."
- 8 The disciples told Him, "Rabbi, Judeans were now seeking to stone You, so are You going there again?"
- <sup>9</sup> Jesus answered, "Are there not twelve hours of daytime? If anyone walks during daytime he does not stumble, because he sees the light of this world.
- <sub>10</sub> But if anyone walks during night he stumbles, because the light is not in him."
- <sub>11</sub> He said these *things*, but after this He told them, "Our friend Lazarus has fallen asleep, but I am going so I may wake him."
- <sub>12</sub> So His disciples said, "Lord, if he has fallen asleep he will be delivered."
- 13 Although Jesus had spoken about his death, they supposed He was speaking about restful sleep.
- <sub>14</sub> So Jesus then told them openly, "Lazarus died. <sub>15</sub> And I rejoice for your• sake, so you• may believe because I was not there. But let us go to him."
- <sub>16</sub> So Thomas called Twin said to his fellow disciples, "Let us also go, so we may die with Him."

<b>Jesus: The Resurrection and the Life (11:17–27)</b> <sub>17</sub> So upon arriving, Jesus found he already had been in the tomb four days. <sub>18</sub> Now Bethany was near Jerusalem, almost two miles away.
<sub>19</sub> And many of the Judeans had come to the <i>women</i> around Martha and Mary, so they might console them about their brother.
<sub>20</sub> So, when Martha heard that Jesus was coming, she met Him, but Mary was sitting at home.
21 So Martha told Jesus, "Lord, if You had been here, my brother would not have died,
"but even now I know that God will give You whatever things You may ask God."
<sub>23</sub> Jesus told her, "Your brother will rise."
24 Martha said to Him, "I know that he will rise in the resurrection in the last day."
$_{25}$ Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and I am the life. He who believes in Me, even if he dies, will live.
<sup>26</sup> "And everyone who lives and believes in Me will never ever die. Do you believe <i>all</i> this?"
<sup>27</sup> She told Him, "Yes, Lord, I have <i>already</i> believed that You are the Christ, the Son of God, the <i>One</i> coming into the world."
