Address to those Jews who rely on the law and boast in God (2:17-18)

Jews see themselves as guides for the blind (2:19)

Jews see themselves as correcting foolish ones, since they have the law (2:20)

Teachers of others must learn [to apply] their own teaching (2:21a)

Those preaching, "Thou shalt not steal," must not steal (2:21b)

Those preaching, "Thou shalt not commit adultery," must not commit adultery (2:22a)

Those preaching, “Thou shalt not make graven images,” must not rob temples (2:22b)

Lawbreaking boasters-in-the-law dishonor God (2:23)

Gentiles blaspheme the name of God because of hypocritical religious Jews (2:24)

Circumcision does not profit lawbreakers (2:25)

Uncircumcised lawkeepers exceed circumcised lawbreakers (2:26-27)

True Jews are Jews (descendants of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob) with circumcised hearts (2:28-29)
